A dental implant is actually a three-part fixture consisting of a titanium screw, an abutment (or connector) and the actual replacement tooth, called a crown. In the case of many missing teeth, several implants may support a set of fake teeth, called a fixed bridge.

At New Smiles, we perform the oral surgery for your implant in house, without outsourcing to a different surgeon. We use local anesthetic to ensure a painless and peaceful procedure, and employ CT scan technology to get the most accurate representation of your bones and mouth structure possible.

A dental implant requires two surgeries. It typically takes six to nine months of healing before the crown can be attached to the titanium screw, but the results are well worth it.

Dental implants restore your ability to chew properly, prevent the "sunken face" look that comes with shifting teeth and boost your self esteem. They require none of the messy adhesives and embarrassment of removable dentures. With proper care, most dental implants can last a lifetime.

So why wait? A gap in your dentition causes the bone beneath to wear away, eventually requiring more surgery to fix.
